OneFamily was established 22 years ago with it's main mission being to ease the pain of the victims of terrorism and bypassing bureaucracy, so as to offer them immediate help in meeting all their initial needs, and to continue accompanying the families on their long road to physical and mental recovery.

During our 22 years of activity, OneFamily has deployed over 400 volunteers and its staff of social workers, psychologists and heads of divisions, who have been present for thousands of bereaved families, for the wounded and their family members, and for all those who have fallen victim to acts of terror.

Assistance is provided in every facet of life, wherever help is required, which includes accompanying victims to treatments, financial assistance, legal assistance, offering a big brother or big sister to younger children, arranging home visits, providing therapeutic responses, retreats to relax the mind and body, and teaming victims with professionals so that they can deal with their innermost pain.

OneFamily provides therapeutic activities for children, youth, and young adults, including sleepaway camps, empowerment workshops, and ways to learn how to continue in life, and cope with the difficulties that have been imposed on them in everyday life.

OneFamily accompanies the victims hand-in-hand, sometimes throughout their lives. In 2022 alone, we lost 23 civilians and eight soldiers, and over 200 were wounded.

The wave of terror continued into 2023, and the atrocities of October 2023 hit us hard. We are still experiencing their impact and pray that Israel will be met with no more sorrow.

We would like to take this opportunity to inform and invite all the families who need us, that we are here to help, support and accompany them; to be a listening ear, a shoulder to lean on, and to offer them a warm embrace. This is precisely the mission of One Family.

We would also like to thank this opportunity to thank all our thank all our dedicated volunteers and those who support us financially, socially, and emotionally, as well as all the members of the association for their blessed work.

I would like to conclude with a prayer: May the year that that has brought curses on us end and may a new year begin with its blessings.




SOURCES OF FUNDS - 262 14,435,280 ILS






